Both the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge run on a collegiate system considered to be the most successful around the world. Each of their colleges has an average population of 300 to 600 students. Faculty staff and students share a close intellectual bond and interact frequently. Some of the education there takes place outside the classroom. As one of the nine CUHK Colleges, S.H. Ho College is dedicated to building a closely-knit community, through full residential and communal arrangements to bring faculty staff and students together. Efforts are made jointly with its students to foster a home-like environment on campus. Thrice a week, the students attend communal dinners with their peers and faculty members. A high table dinner with the same turnout is held once every month. Under the family-like atmosphere of communal dining, S.H. Ho students take time off their busy schedules to gather under the same roof, to exchange their insights into campus life and learning. Hailing from different academic backgrounds, they reside at Ho Tim Hall and Lee Quo Wei Hall and are collectively exposed to whole-person education outside their disciplines, as a part of their youthful progression.

The College General Education Programme is mandatory for all students studying at CUHK. At S.H. Ho College, the programme combines extremely challenging activities with thought-provoking topics carried out in three phases titled 'Adventure', 'Reflection' and 'Expression', to help smoothen the transition for freshmen from secondary school to university life. As autumn deepened in October, S.H. Ho freshmen joined an overnight camp in the outback. 

More than 700 students have attended the gatherings so far, a number exceeding the entire student population of the College. Mrs. Sun would prepare cookies, cakes and snacks, while Master Sun would make fruit punch and other refreshments. At the gatherings, the conversation would touch on the University, the College, academic studies and any area of life. Like Master Sun, Mrs. Sun cares deeply for S.H. Ho students, particularly their diet and health. Besides the tea receptions, Mrs. Sun also holds cookie classes at the Pine Lodge, sharing the healthy cookie recipes she has modified with her guests. This includes substituting white sugar with honey. She also adds in healthy ingredients like dried currants and walnuts to make the cookies tastier. 'Regardless of the afternoon teas or cookie classes, I treasure the moments spent together with the students and sharing with them my insights of life. I treat S. H. Ho students like my own children and they are my friends too. Some students did not know each other before but after attending the activities together at the Pine Lodge, they have eventually

I had just attended the inauguration of the new Resident Councils, formed by several local and non-local students from Ho Tim Hall and Lee Quo Wei Hall. Taking the oath at the inauguration ceremony witnessed by the Master and Wardens, the new council members dedicated themselves to organizing various social gatherings and recreational activities to deepen the friendship of students and strengthen their sense of affiliation to the College. In 2010, after the first batch of students was admitted to the College, a Representative Council for the students was rapidly formed in the first academic semester. The Student Union Constitution of S.H. Ho College was drafted and the first Executive Council elected. Chung Yiu Wa, one of the second-intake students, became President of CUHK Student Union, the first to hail from a new College. People are the most critical element of a 'home'. Without the mutual support of family members and their commitments for one another, home is at most a house.



Exploratory



踏入初夏,我為人生第一次的海外馬拉松賽事進行最後階段特訓,而我兩位朋友參加了書院舉辦的夏季海外體驗活動。那位剛從柬埔寨回港的朋友,雀躍地跟我分享她探訪貧民窟居民和孤兒院的體驗,以至為村民義診的經歷,她發現居於垃圾山的居民縱然面對劣境,仍對改善生活滿懷希望,其樂觀的生活態度十分鼓舞人心。另一位朋友剛考察完夏威夷玻里尼西亞文化,也告訴我體驗原住民文化的見聞,在火山區親手觸摸冷卻了的熔岩,以及親臨珍珠港感受二次大戰時戰爭的殘酷。千里之行始於足下,服務體驗和文化考察實在是開拓視野的好機會,有助我們了解弱勢社群和多元文化的社會,讓我們更懂得如何在求學階段裝備自己,學習做個有承擔感的知識青年。

Early summer was underway and I was in the final stage of training for my first-ever overseas marathon race. Two of my friends had also taken part in other overseas experiential activities arranged by the College. One of them, who just returned from Cambodia, was all excited as she shared with me the experiences she had from visiting the residents of a slum and an orphanage there. She also recounted how she provided the slum residents with free health consultations. She discovered that despite their deplorable living conditions, the Dumping Hill residents seemed hopeful of improving their lives, reflecting an optimism that moved her considerably. Another friend of mine who had just completed his Polynesian cultural exploration in Hawaii told me his observation of the aboriginals. In the volcanic region, he touched the cooled molten lava with his hands. He also visited Pearl Harbour where he contemplated on the brutalities of the Second World War. As a thousand-mile journey begins with a single step, the service experiences and cultural field trips are designed to provide us with valuable firsthand opportunities to broaden our horizons internationally. They also offer us a deeper understanding of marginal groups and the multifaceted nature of societies. Furthermore, they enable us to learn how to equip ourselves in our learning stage and become knowledgeable, socially committed youths.

回顧大學本科的日子,靖文有感環球商業學的課程設計靈活,學生的文化背景多樣化,有助她更深入了解世界,欣賞不同的文化。「我發現要在商業社會或其他範疇追求卓越表現,了解別人的想法是關鍵,所以我決心成為謙遜的學者,學習理解不同的人、社會和文化。」出於對文化研究的熱忱,她考入劍橋大學亞洲及中東研究學院攻讀一年的碩士課程。

劍橋的學習生活既豐富又有啟發性。很多碩士課程以論 壇形式進行,教師會要求同學在上課前完成指定閱讀, 並且在課堂與同儕展開仁智互見的討論。起初,吳靖文 覺得自己的社會科學根底不像其他同學一樣深厚,要在 課堂中發言倍感掙扎。「上了過幾課後,我們才適應這 種學習模式,而且從中得到啟發,課堂所涉獵的範疇廣 泛,同學的求知慾強,我往往在深入的討論中獲益良多。 學院的迎新日教我印象難忘,當時我遇見一位以色列同 學,她侃侃分享對於《淮南子》中文修辭的研究,令我驚 訝不已。| Looking back on her undergraduate days, Cynthia felt that the curriculum of the Global Business Studies course was flexibly designed and that its students came from diverse cultural backgrounds, which helped her to develop a deeper understanding of the world and appreciation of its myriad cultures. 'I realized that knowing how people think is key to success in business and other areas of life. This was why I decided to become an academician and endeavored to understand different people, societies and cultures.' Out of a passion for cultural studies, she succeeded in enrolling into a one-year Master's Programme at the Faculty of Asian and Middle Eastern Studies in The University of Cambridge.

At Cambridge, the learning experience is both enriching and inspiring. Many Master's programme courses are carried out in discussion format. Lecturers require their students to complete the reading assignments and engage in intelligent two-way discourses with their peers. Initially, Cynthia felt she lacked a strong foundation in the social sciences compared to her classmates, making it a struggle for her to speak up in front of everybody. 'It was only after a few lessons that we adapted to this learning mode and gain inspiration from it. Our tutorials covered a vast array of topics, matched by a strong quest for knowledge in the students. Invariably, I benefited immensely from the in-depth discussions. Orientation Day at my college left me with an indelible impression as I met a classmate from Israel who generously shared her insights into the finer details of rhetoric in Huainanzi (an ancient Chinese philosophical classic).'

As for college and social life at Cambridge, it is the distinctive Oxbridge tradition of high-table dining that Cynthia cherishes most. 'As opposed to the high-table dinners at S.H. Ho and other CUHK Colleges, the dining hall culture of Oxbridge allows students the freedom to join the high-table dinners of different colleges.' The rationale is that by letting students attend the high-table dinners of each other's colleges, they could broaden their own social networks and know more friends from different disciplines. She added, 'When I first arrived at Cambridge, my college tutor made a deliberate effort to remind me to think in advance about how I should introduce my own academic specialty and research interests in a succinct manner. This would be how carry out our self-introduction whenever we start a conversation with others we meet for the first time.' She surmised that such an arrangement is to encourage students to acquaint with each other in a proper yet light-hearted way, while enabling them to share knowledge meaningfully.

During semester time, Cynthia and her friends joined the activities organized by Hughes Hall and the university, which included attending the Michaelmas Term Concert performed by the Cambridge Graduate Orchestra and the Apple Day at the Cambridge Botanical Garden. The locals also celebrated Bonfire Night, a British tradition, with firework displays. 'Pursuing my further education at The University of Cambridge for a year has been a great experience for me. It was there that I found academic inspiration,' she said.
