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Background – 2017 Policy Address

2017 Policy Address – Primary Healthcare

- Set up a **District Health Centre** with a brand new operation mode in Kwai Tsing District within two years.
- Make use of the local network to procure services from organisations and healthcare personnel serving the district

2018 Policy Address – Primary Healthcare

- To effectively **change the current focus** of our healthcare services **on treatment** and to alleviate the pressure on public hospitals
- The DHC will be a service hub



District Health Centre Scheme

- Enhance public awareness of disease prevention
- Enhance their capability in self-management of health
- Provide **support** for the chronically ill



Community-based

- <u>Convenient</u> location of <u>Core</u> Centre and Satellite Centres
- Local consultation and monitoring

DHC

- Public-Private
 - Partnership
- Appoint <u>DHC Operator</u> through open tender
- Purchase services from private service providers

Medical-Social Collaboration

- <u>Collaboration</u> with NGOs, other local service partners



Key Services of DHC

- Primary Prevention Services
 - Health promotion, advisory and counselling services
 - Health educational programmes
 - Basic assessment for chronic diseases risk factors
- Secondary Prevention Services
 - Health assessment and screening to facilitate early identification of chronic diseases

• Tertiary Prevention Services


- Chronic diseases management services hypertension, diabetes mellitus, musculoskeletal disorder
- Community Rehabilitation services stroke, post acute myocardial infarction and hip fracture



Key Services of DHC

- Primary Prevention Services (examples)
 - Healthy eating
 - Fall prevention programme
 - Sarcopenia prevention programme
 - Frailty prevention programme
 - Diabetes prevention programme
 - Prevention of degenerative joint disease
 - Alcohol abstinence
 - Smoking cessation
 - Relaxation technique
 - Stress management
 - Sleep hygiene
