The course comprises three micro-modules focusing on care management of common geriatric-orthopedic conditions, common geriatric syndrome among this patient group and innovative care models in fall prevention and end-of-life care. The contents will cover the following aspects

Course Description:

This course aims at develop the professional knowledge and skill of students in providing comprehensive care for common geriatric orthopaedic conditions (degenerative disease, fracture and spinal problems) and to effectively manage the common geriatric syndromes (such as delirium, incontinence, and malnutrition) among this disease cohort. The course also develops the students' ability to apply evidence-based care models for fall prevention and end-of-life care promotion.

 - Discuss the evidence-based practice to manage the typical symptoms among geriatric orthopedic conditions.
 - Discuss the application of evidence-based care model in fall prevention among geriatric orthopedic conditions
 - Discuss the application of end-of-life care model to improve the health outcomes of patients with geriatric orthopedic condition and their families.
