COURSE OUTLINE

This is a 39-hour course to cover:-

- Theoretical concepts of grief, grieving process and reaction
- How to disclose bad news and answer questions
- Consequences of losing a uterus in childbearing age
- Support to family with adverse birth outcome or maternal death
- Complicated grief: referral and management
- Counseling strategies and applications
- Self care: how to face death and go through intense emotions
- Grief therapy in the virtual world

INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Identify types of grief reactions
- Understand and utilize theories related to grief
- Appropriately ask questions that lead to identification of loss experiences
- Improve skill in working with families during the crisis
- Identify bereaved women who may require additional support from mental health experts

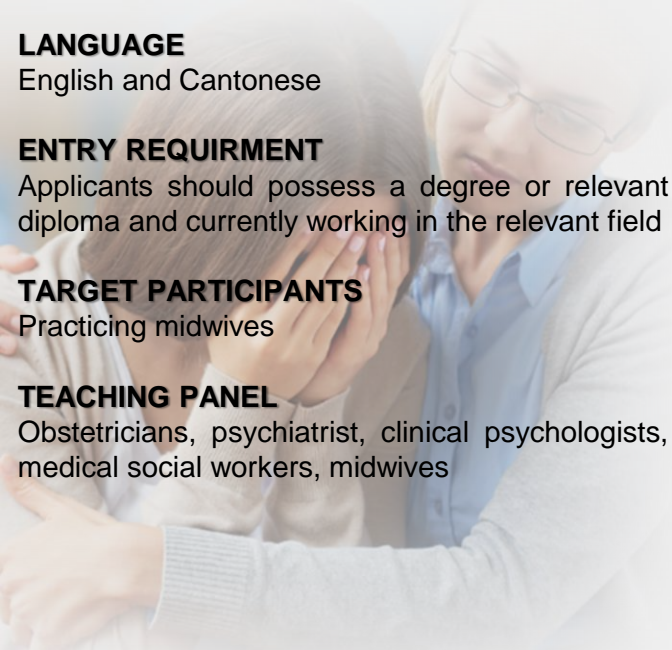
