ABOUT THE COURSE

This course is designed for the health care professionals involved in the treatment of the infertile male. We provide training in the assessment of parameters of male reproductive function, and assist professionals in identifying strategies for the treatment of male infertility.

The course includes:

1. The physiology and pathophysiology of male reproductive function;
2. Key elements of the male factor evaluation;
3. Basic and advanced testing of reproductive function;
4. Surgical and nonsurgical treatments of male infertility;
5. Strategies for male fertility preservation.
