Professional Training Course in Hypnobirthing

Hypnobirthing is a complete birth education programme that teaches simple but specific self-hypnosis, relaxation and breathing techniques for a more comfortable birth. Although birth can be described as a natural instinctive process, society has medicalised the concept of birth to a point where women accept medical intervention as 'normal' and therefore feel less confident in their ability to birth.

Hypnobirthing prepares parents to take control of their birthing process to make informed decisions leading to an empowering experience that they will remember for life.

Objectives

- ✓ To understand the principles of hypnosis for birth
- ✓ To have ability to empower parents to informed decision making
- ✓ To be confident in teaching parents techniques for a calm comfortable birth
- ✓ To feel empowered to plan and teach a hypnobirthing course

Course Design

The course is delivered through lectures and interactive case discussion with 18 teaching hours.

Target Participants

Midwives who are caring pregnant women and infants in both out-patient and in-patient setting.

Applicants should possess a BSc degree or relevant diploma.
