

# One to One Midwives in UK



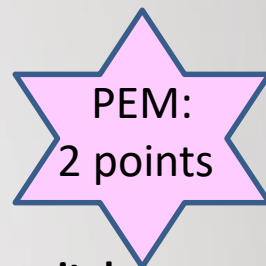
**Background:** Students of Master Obs & Mid Care have completed a 5-day UK clinical placement in a community care setting
