The Divinity School of Chung Chi College is an academic unit in the Department of Cultural and Religious Studies of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, offering study programmes in Theology and Christian Studies. Together with five supporting Churches (the Anglican Church, the Church of Christ in China (Hong Kong Council), the Tsung Tsin Mission, the Methodist Church, and the Hong Kong and Pentecostal Holiness Church), the School also aims at training pastoral workers, raising the level of theologizing of the laity, and promoting theological research. The School now invites applications and nominations of qualified candidates for the above post.

Applicants should have (i) a relevant PhD or ThD degree; (ii) an established record of scholarship appropriate for an academic appointment at Professor or Associate Professor rank; (iii) solid relationship with the Divinity School of Chung Chi College and the supporting Churches of the School; (iv) experience in providing theological education; (v) pastoral experience, including voluntary church leadership work; (vi) administrative experience; and (vii) a good command of English and Chinese (including Putonghua).

The selected candidate will be offered an academic appointment (at Professor or Associate Professor rank) jointly in the Department of Cultural and Religious Studies and the Divinity School of Chung Chi College, to be held concomitantly with an appointment also as the Director of the Divinity School of Chung Chi College. The appointee will be required to reside on campus. Appointment will initially be made on contract basis for up to three years commencing August 2014, which, subject to mutual agreement, may lead to longer-term appointment or substantiation later.

Salary and Fringe Benefits

Salary will be highly competitive, commensurate with qualifications and experience. The University offers a comprehensive fringe benefit package, including medical care, plus a contract-end gratuity for appointments of two years or longer.
