

The D. H. Chen Foundation Scholarship 2021/22



The D. H. Chen Foundation Scholarship covers **renewable full tuition fee and living allowance plus overseas exchange allowance**. The awardees will also be offered unique opportunities, such as social good initiative, mentorship, scholars network, internship, annual reception and Vice-Chancellor/President roundtable.

To be eligible for this Scholarship, applicants must be permanent residents of Hong Kong, full-time Year 1 undergraduate students of UGC-funded programs, have achieved a Year GPA of at least 3.5 out of 4.0 (or equivalent) with ALL letter grades of courses taken available in 2020/21.
