# The Hong Kong Jockey Club Scholarships 2021/22

Established in 1998, The Hong Kong Jockey Club Scholarships (Website: <a href="http://jcscholarships.hk/">http://jcscholarships.hk/</a>) aim to nurture outstanding talents to become compassionate leaders who will create positive change and inspire the wider society to strive for excellence.

## The Scholarships

In 2021/22, up to five awards will be offered:

- Four awards will be available for Hong Kong students (including one with special educational needs (hereafter "SEN")).
- One award will be available for a student from Mainland China.

The value of each award, subject to review and adjustments, is estimated at HK\$113,000 for local students and HK\$215,900 for Mainland students annually. The scholarship will **cover tuition fee, academic expenses and living costs for the entire normal length of study towards an undergraduate degree programme**.

# Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be permanent residents of HKSAR <u>OR</u> citizens of the People's Republic of China;
- be full-time first-year or second-year students studying their <u>first</u> undergraduate degree in the academic year 2021/22;
- have a high standard of academic performance;
- be proficient in written and spoken Chinese (Cantonese or Putonghua) and English; and
- provide proofs for their special educational needs (for local SEN applicants only).

Please refer to the application documents for all the eligibility requirements and selection criteria.
