The Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) continuously holds activities with different working partners to educate the youth the anti-corruption messages and promote the importance of integrity. In the 2013/14 academic year, the ICAC jointly organizes the “i-Relay” Youth Integrity Project with the Commission on Youth, Committee on the Promotion of Civic Education, local tertiary institutions and renowned youth associations. It is to reinforce young people’s understanding of youth integrity and encourage exchange on related topics such as money management as well as a fruitful life.
