



Promoting Active Learning to enhance students' competence

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A major concern of our school during the 2018-2019 school year is to promote Active Learning among our students in order to enhance their competence. And to ensure success in our endeavor, we have sought professional support from "The Quality School Improvement Project (QSIP)", an initiative established under the Hong Kong Institute of Educational Research (HKIER) of the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). On Tuesday 28 August and subsequently on Monday 24 September, workshops were held during which the CUHK scholars advised our teachers on the pre-requisites and teaching skills necessary for turning students' Active Learning into reality. It is agreed that a main focus of our effort in the present school year is to help our girls to form the important and useful habit of preparing their own personalized notes, which is essential to effective revision and hence better performance in academic pursuit.


