The Center for Entrepreneurship's mission is to inspire a passion for, and an understanding of, entrepreneurship among the staff and students of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) and the wider community. The Center is a multi-disciplinary organization dedicated to promoting entrepreneurship through:

- **Research** - The Center seeks to understand this force through scholarly and applied research. Since 2002, the Center has been a member of the Global Entrepreneurship Monitor (GEM). It works with business and research organizations in Hong Kong and Greater China to identify and investigate the issues affecting entrepreneurship.
- **Education** - The Center's education programme enhances and expands the University's current offering of courses in entrepreneurship. The activities include seminars, workshops, and visits to entrepreneurial ventures.
- **Practice** - The Center helps students plan new companies that create value by satisfying market needs. It encourages students, faculty, alumni and members of the community to form multi-disciplinary teams.

The Center organizes the Vice-Chancellor's Cup of Student Entrepreneurship. Past champions include:

- Maxway International with their patented device called Rat Climbing Preventer which can effectively prevent the rats from climbing up various objects, particularly the water pipes and trees, without using any chemical or electricity.
- Nanopure, a laundry and consulting service for garments used in the cleanrooms of high technology equipment manufacturers
- InMotion, which planned to produce a device based on micro input systems and micro electrical mechanical systems motion sensing to capture what is hand-written on any surface and input the writing to a computing platform using bluetooth technology
- Golden Health, which planned to use ECGs and optics technology to accurately measure blood pressure without the need for a cuff. The Golden Health team later established themselves as "Colisa Limited" and are now resident in Science Park
- MIDS Mouse Terminator, which planned to use motion sensing technology to replace the computer mouse as an input device for computers. The team leader took his technology to start-up under the name Sengital Limited, and is now resident in Science Park.
