| <b>Application Procedures</b> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete and submit an online application form before the application deadline with the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>an updated transcript (a downloaded student copy from CUSIS is acceptable)</li> <li>a copy of your term paper related to Taoism (applicable for the application of Shun Shin Kindness Foundation Scholarship)</li> <li>a copy of your term paper related to Christianity (applicable for the application of St. Francis Xavier Scholarship)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Selected candidates will be invited for an interview if deemed necessary.</li> <li>Late or incomplete applications will not be processed by the Department.</li> </ol> |  |   | The Department will shortlist candidates among the final-year students based on academic merit (overall GPA results).
