The Baker & McKenzie LLB Prize

Terms and Conditions

Baker & McKenzie, Solicitors and Notaries, ("the Donor") has kindly agreed to donate a sum of \$50,000 ("the Prize") to a student from The Chinese University of Hong Kong with effect from the academic year 2008/09. Regulations governing the award of the Prize are detailed below:

- 1. The Prize will be known as "The Baker & McKenzie LLB Prize" and in Chinese as 貝克·麥堅時獎.
- 2. A sum of \$50,000 shall be awarded. The recipient of the Prize shall be a CUHK full-time LLB student enrolled in Year 3 of the LLB degree.
- 3. Selection is based on the following:
 - academic merit;
 - other qualities, including leadership and personality; and
 - preference will be given to applicants who plan to graduate from the LLB programme in the academic year following their selection for the Prize.
- 4. The Prize shall be awarded subject to the student:
 - (a) completing a 4 week summer clerkship with Baker & McKenzie in the calendar year in which he/she is selected to receive the Prize; and
 - (b) if offered, having accepted a solicitor's traineeship contract with Baker & McKenzie (the contract to commence in the September following the student's satisfactory completion and passing of the Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (P.C.LL.) programme).
- 5. The Donor reserves the right to not award the Prize after the selection process.
- 6. The Donor shall give the University an advance notice prior to the commencement of a new academic year if the Prize is to cease.
