**Addleshaw Goddard Prizes for Civil Procedure**

Regulations

Addleshaw Goddard LLP (the “Donor”) will donate an annual sum of HK\$10,000 for two prizes (the “Prizes”) to the Faculty of Law (the “Faculty”) of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (the “University”) on an annual basis with effect from the academic year 2019-20. Regulations governing the award of the Prizes are detailed below:

1. The Prizes will be known as “Addleshaw Goddard Prizes for Civil Procedure”.
2. There are two Prizes and each of the Prizes is HK\$5,000. The total amount of the Prizes is HK\$10,000.
  - (i) One Prize of HK\$5,000 shall be awarded to a current final year student enrolled in the Bachelor of Laws programme of the Faculty who achieves the highest overall mark in the undergraduate course *LAWS3100 Civil Procedure* offered by the Faculty.
  - (ii) One Prize of HK\$5,000 shall be awarded to a current final year student enrolled in the Juris Doctor programme of the Faculty who achieves the highest overall mark in the postgraduate course *LAWS6012 Principles of Civil Procedure* offered by the Faculty.
3. In the event that more than one student achieves the highest overall mark in the course specified in (i) and (ii) above, the Prizes shall be divided equally among these students.
4. Each academic year, the Dean of the Faculty will nominate the Prize Recipient(s). The particulars of the Prize recipients will be sent to the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid (the “OFA”) for onward transmission to the Donor for information.
5. The Donor shall notify the University prior to the beginning of each academic year if the arrangements set out in these Regulations are to be varied or discontinued.
