



Are you Eligible?

- Have a valid TOEFL or IELTS score report if required (counting from on or after 1 Sep 2020)
- In good academic and disciplinary standing (most of the institutions require
 CGPA >=3) at CUHK
- * Have basic knowledge of the country or region where you intend to study
- * Should display maturity and responsibility in social conduct
- physically and emotionally healthy
- * Applicants must be registered full-time undergraduate students at the time of application and while on exchange
- Ready to be an exchange student representing CUHK & LWS College
- * Have to complete the course registered with passing grades in the exchanged university
- * Willing to share your exchange experience with fellow students when you are back

When considering of your choices...

You MUST think about:

- Your personal and cultural interests
- Can you meet the Programme requirement?
 - Check GPA
 - Check Language
- Do the institutions offer courses of your study area?
 - Check available discipline and remarks
- Can you afford the cost of living of the country?

Q: Can I apply for the exchange programme if I have not yet taken the language test before the application deadline?

(Given that you decide to choose the universities that have requirement on the TOEFL/IELTS score)

A: Yes, but you must provide a proof of your order/details of the IELTS / TOEFL test.

Please reminded the deadline of updating the test result, i.e. Jan 2022, to College.

For Language test, scores from the same sitting are counted only. Combined certificate is not counted.

Q: Can I accept offers from both OAL and College?
A: Can accept one offer only if you apply & receive nominations from both OAL and the Colleges in the first placement round

2nd placement round: No new applications will be accepted, eligible students will be invited to apply for the second round via email



Q: Which term does the required GPA refer to? Does the GPA in question mean the cumulated one or the term one only?

A: The required GPA refers to the cumulated GPA in Term 1, 2021-2022.

* Please be reminded of updating it to the College on or before Jan 2022.



Q: Do I need to apply for extension of study period for the exchange?

A: All final Year Undergraduate Students who are shortlisted must seek their major Department's pre-approval for extension of student period at CUHK by completing the "Application for Extension of Study Period" form. They CANNOT choose the 2nd term programmes.

Note

If students' expected graduation term is the first term of the current academic year (i.e. 2022-23, Term 1), they are <u>ineligible</u> to apply for the exchange programmes.



Q: Are credits transferable?

A: Credits may be transferred back to CUHK in accordance with appropriate regulations of CUHK

Selection Interview

- * Shortlisted students will be invited to interview
- * Interview panel: Staff/ Teachers from Lee Woo Sing College
- * Evaluation will be based on 5 categories of personal attributes



Evaluation Criteria

Personal Attributes

A: Commitment and Potential:

Objectives, study plan and goal setting

B: Determination & Enthusiasm:

Preparation work done, level of understanding of the institution and the Country

C: Personality & Suitability:

Adaptability/ Maturity/ Personal suitability/ Interpersonal skills

D: Communication:

Language proficiency/ presentation & communication skills

E: Achievements & Contributions:

College ambassador/ Extra-curricular activities/ Awards & honors

Selection process

After the interview:

- 1. Priority for each institution will be given to student who has the **highest scores** and there after (the score will not be announced)
- Applicant who have never exchanged before during his study years in CUHK will be considered first

Selection process

Procedure	Action Item
Early Jan – mid Jan	Change of choices and update results
Mid Jan 2022	Update your latest Accumulated GPA and language test results
28 Jan 2022	Announcement of selection results by email
On or before 4 Feb 2022	Accepting your offer

- * Complete and sign the offer letter
- * pay a deposit of \$1500. The deposit is fully refundable upon completion of exchange programme and fulfillment of other requirements, for example students should enroll at least full time credit load at their intuition and get a pass on all subjects.
- * You may be required to attend a debriefing session and a sharing session after you return from the exchange programme if needed.



Q: What if I cannot attend the interview?

A: If you are shortlisted, you must attend the interview if you would like us to process your application.

Students must submit a good cause request for rescheduling the interview. Experiential Learning and Global Engagement Committee would determine on a case by case basis.

Q: How the College contact me about the application states?

A: Every important message will be delivered to you via your email. Make sure you check your email account frequently once you apply for the exchange.

Q: What will be the following if I accept the exchange offer?

A: After you accept the offer and finish the procedure required, a study advisor from OAL will contact you soon to arrange your case with you. Be patient!
