## e-Campus



### CU Link

The 'CU Link' is a smart card issued to all student and staff members. It carries the following functions:

- **University ID card** – the cardholder's personal information is printed on the card and stored in the chips of the card as a proof of identity.
- **Access permit** – to facilitate speedy authentication for entering libraries, computer rooms, laboratories, offices, sports centres and hostels, etc.
- **Library card** – to borrow books, log into public PCs in libraries and retrieve library resources.
- **Attendance taking** – to complete the sign up procedure by placing the card over a card reader at College assemblies, seminars or workshops.
- **e-Wallet** – to make electronic payments, to switch on the air-conditioner, washing machine, dryer and extractor in hostels.

### MyCUHK

MyCUHK is a one-stop portal for personalized access to various online resources offered by CUHK. Go to the MyCUHK front page (<https://portal.cuhk.edu.hk>) and key in the login ID (i.e. student, staff or alumnus/alumna ID number) and password to browse the following:

- **MyPage** – quick access to class and course information, change password, staff self-service enquiry, e-Ticketing system, etc.
- **News and Events** – updates on the University's news and events
- **CUSIS and MyStudy/MyTeaching** – e-learning platform, VeriGuide and Moodle, etc.
- **Library** – access to library catalogue, library records and MyLibrary, etc.
- **Webmail** – send and receive e-mails through the campus-wide e-mail system
- **Useful Links** – information on learning and campus life

## CUSIS

The Chinese University Student Information System (CUSIS) can be accessed via the MyCUHK portal. Students can manage a range of personal and academic information through CUSIS, e.g., to process registration, update personal information, pay school fees, register in classes, view official grades, apply for exemptions, change/declare concentration, submit financial aids and scholarship application forms, and check learning progress, etc. Details are available at: [www.cuhk.edu.hk/cusis](http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/cusis). CUSIS is also accessible to staff and alumni.

## Wi-Fi

A wireless LAN has been installed on campus covering most of the public open areas, libraries, major classrooms, student hostels and student canteens. 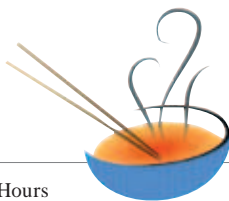

### Colleges and Hostels





In the next couple of years, more new hostel buildings will be completed to accommodate the increasing number of students. The cross-cultural living environment of the International House (I-House) managed by the Office of Student Affairs provides another option for students from Hong Kong, China and overseas.






The University Station of the MTR East Rail is located just outside the main campus. Visitors may take Kowloon Motor Bus Nos. 72, 72A, 73A, 74A or 872, and disembark at Tai Po Road (near Chung Chi Campus). Those who take the green mini-bus 28K may disembark at Tai Po Road (near Chung Chi campus) or at the main entrance of CUHK. Those taking buses 87K, 87S, 272K or 289K, and green mini-buses 807A, 807B, 807K or 807P, should disembark at the bus terminus next to the University MTR Station.

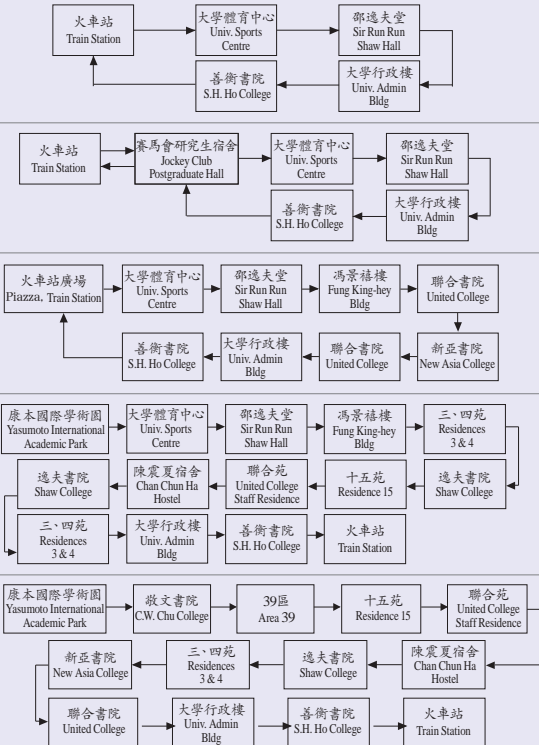

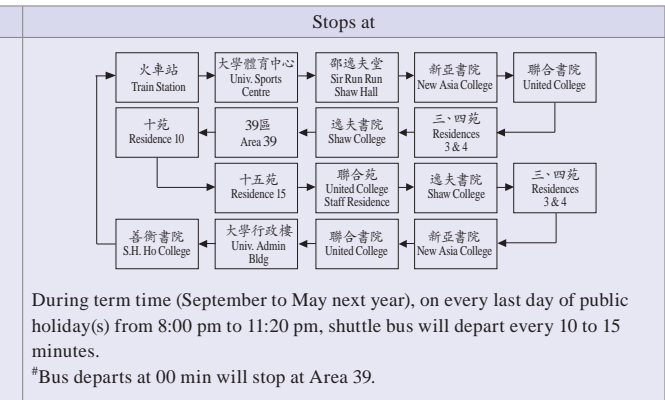
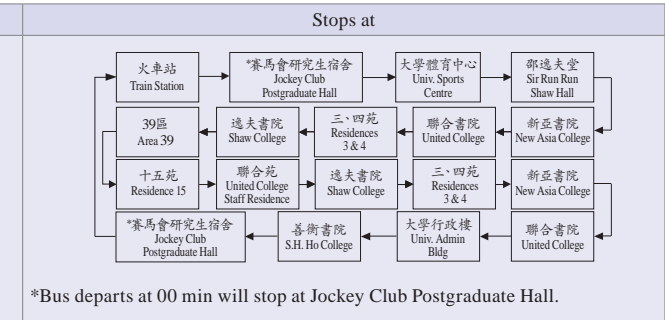

Driving visitors should get an hourly parking ticket upon entering the campus and pay the parking fee prior to departure. - Remains open for one more hour after typhoon signal no. 8 has been issued, and re-opens when the no. 8 signal is lowered.

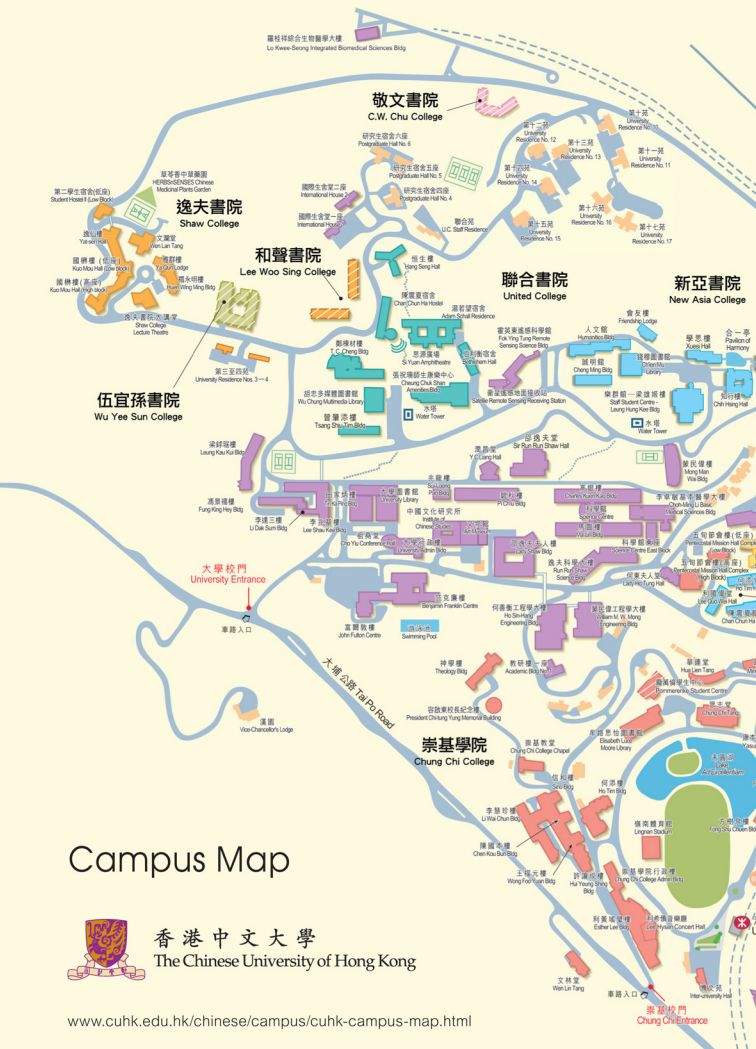

- Call the University Health Service at 3943 6423; or
- Proceed to the Accident & Emergency Department of Prince of Wales Hospital, Sha Tin; or
- Call '999' for ambulance service, identify yourself and give exact location. It is advisable to notify the Security Office at 3943 7999, as the security patrol cars have been equipped with AED to perform Automated External Defibrillation when necessary before the ambulance arrives. Also the ambulance can be directed to the exact location more readily.
