

香港中文大學聯合書院 通識教育課程

通識教育之目的在於培養學生的治學與處事能力，擴闊其視野，使學生在本身的主修學科以外具有更廣博的知識基礎，從而對大學的價值、目的和求學方法有正確的了解。通識教育協助學生有效地參與大學和書院的生活，培養多方面的興趣，並著重鼓勵學生發展獨立思考、判斷能力及服務社會之意識，使學能備適應當今社會急劇之演變。

2022 至 23 年度或以前入學的本科生適用

聯合書院學生必須修滿大學規定之通識教育科目，連同書院所設計及指定之通識教育科目在內，合共 21 學分，始准畢業（惟特許專業法律課程，學生只須修讀上述規定科目至少 12 學分）。

註：特許專業課程法律學院開辦之課程，學生只需修讀 6 個大學通識學分。

1. GEJ 0112 【書院、大學與社會】乃四書院為一年級學生共同開設的書院通識科目，並以英語為授課語言。每間書院學額 25 名，優先給予使用中文有困難的學生修讀，餘下學額則公開給其他一年級學生申請，惟必須經書院通識教育事務處核准，並退選 GEU 1011 【大學生活與學習】。
2. 此乃持有副學士學位的高年級入學學生修讀的科目，如同學要選 GEUC 4012，必須完成先修科目 GEUC 2103。
3. 以高級條件入讀大學一年級課程的學生，不會獲得任何書院通識教育學分的豁免。

學生除依書院之規定修讀上表所列之書院通識教育必修科目外，亦須選修大學通識教育基礎課程及四個範圍規定內的科目，詳情請參考大學本科生手冊內的大通識教育課程修讀規定。

GENERAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The United College General Education Programme is designed to broaden the interests of students, give them a wider perspective, and cultivate in them the ability to face the issues of contemporary life. The challenge of rational inquiry, the purposes and values of university learning are also emphasized. It aims to enhance students' capability to meet the needs of the rapid-changing society.

Applicable to students admitted in 2022-23 or before

All students of United College have to take 21 units of General Education courses, which include the courses required by the University and the College, respectively. For students of specifically approved professional programme (LLB), the General Education requirement is 12 units. The unit requirements of General Education courses are as follows:

Note: Specifically approved professional programme is LLB, students only need to take 6 UGE units.

1. *GEJC1120 "College, University and Society" is jointly offered by Chung Chi College, New Asia College and United College to their first-year students and taught in English. Priority will be given to those non-JUPAS and overseas students who have difficulties in the use of Chinese language. The remaining places will be opened for other students to enroll, subject to approval of the College General Education Office. This is the replacement course of GEUC1011.*
2. *This is the preferred course for upper-year entrants holding associate degrees or higher diplomas, if students choose to take GEUC4012, they also have to take the pre-requisite course GEUC2103.*
3. *No exemption in College general education requirements for Advanced Standing to FYFD places.*

In addition to completing the courses required by the College, students also need to complete the requirements of the University General Education Programme in the General Education Foundation (GEF) Programme and the Four Areas of University General Education requirement. Updated General Education Programme Requirement could be found in the Undergraduate Student Handbook or related websites.
