Introduction

Requirements

- During the programme period (27/8/2022-30/4/2023), participants are **not expected** to join any students exchange programme leaving Hong Kong for **more than one month**
- During the programme period (27/8/2022-30/4/2023), participants are <u>not expected</u> to join any off-campus internship programme for <u>more than two weeks</u>
