



2020 – 2021 CUHK Table Tennis Open

- (1)Aims: To promote table tennis, facilitate communication among students and arouse students' interest in table tennis.
To identify potential table tennis players for University Table Tennis Team.
- (2)Date: 27th March, 2021 (Saturday)
- (3)Time: 2:00 – 6:00p.m. (venue is available for practice from 1:30p.m.)
- (4)Venue: Yeung Ming Biu Indoor Sports Centre (University Sports Centre)
- (5)Eligibility: a)All CUHK full-time students are welcome.
b)Current and former university table tennis team players are not allowed.
- (6)Event: a)Men's Singles (maximum of 32 entrants)
b)Women's Singles (maximum of 32 entrants)
- (7)Rules: The tournament will be conducted according to rules and regulations approved by the Hong Kong Table Tennis Association unless otherwise specified.
- (8)System of Play: a)Single Knockout
b)The best of five games (11 points each game) shall be adopted for the preliminary rounds. While on the other hand, the best of seven games shall be adopted for the semi final (best 4) and onwards.
- (9)Official Ball: Double Fish (3 stars) V40+ table tennis ball, white in colour.
- (10)Prize: Trophy will be awarded to the winner, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd runner-up.
- (11)Enrollment: Entry can be made in person at the counter of University Sports Centre with \$50 deposit on a first-come, first-served basis. Deposit will be refunded after the matches except abstention.
- (12)Enrollment Period: From 8th March, 2021 (9:00a.m.) to 18th March, 2021 (5:00p.m.)
- (13)Referee: Players are required to organize an umpire on their own (or without umpire).
- (14)Appeal: The judgement of the convenor would be the final decision.
- (15)Schedule: a)The draw lots for the tournament will be held at the University Sports Centre (Room 103) at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, 19th March, 2021. The fixtures will be announced at the University Sports Centre notice board from 22th March, 2021. In addition, the fixtures will be uploaded at the following web page:

b)Request for re-schedule of match will not be entertained.
c)A player who does not turn up in 5 minutes in respect of the allotted match time, will be disqualified.
