THE PROVIDENCE FOUNDATION OUTWARD BOUND UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME 2021/22

BACKGROUND

The Providence Foundation donates scholarships, bursaries as well as outward bound awards to tertiary institutions in Hong Kong. This year, the Foundation will offer 18 awards for a 7-day Outward Bound Training in Outward Bound Hong Kong to students of The Chinese University of Hong Kong.

OBJECTIVES

The programme aims at developing and improving participants' decision making, communication, leadership, problem solving and team-building skills.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates should

- be aged between 17-25;
- be proficient in written English;
- have good academic background and common sense;
- be in good health condition;
- be fully vaccinated due to the uncertainly of COVID-19 situation, subject to the requirement of the Foundation and Outward Bound;
- have good team spirit, leadership and organization skills; and
- be an undergraduate in any discipline but preference will be given to business students.

PROGRAMME

This is a 7-day programme which will be held from 23 - 29 May 2022. Further details of the programme will be furnished to the successful candidates in future.

EXPENSES

Part of the course fee, among which, \$4,000 will be sponsored by the Providence Foundation and the remaining part will further be sponsored by Outward Bound Hong Kong. The remaining balance, **HK\$800**, will be payable by the participant. (If the total number of valid applicants is more than 3 times the number of awardees, an additional bonus of HK\$300 would be sponsored to each awardee.)

INSURANCE

The course fee does NOT include insurance. Students are required to join the Voluntary Personal Accident Insurance scheme (with a tentative premium of **HK\$130**) through the Outward Bound Hong Kong. Applicants may also purchase additional insurance by themselves.

OBLIGATIONS

Selected candidates will be required to:

- ♦ sign an undertaking;
- provide full COVID-19 vaccination record;
- attend the pre-programme briefing in early-mid May, 2022;
- attend all sessions of the 7-day Outward Bound Training;
- submit individual and group post-training reports within 4 weeks upon completion of the programme; and
- abide by all instructions and regulations stipulated by the Office of Student Affairs, the Outward Bound School and the Providence Foundation.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

A completed application form together with the following documents should be submitted to Student Development and Resources Section of the Office of Student Affairs on 1/F of Benjamin Franklin Centre on or before February 25, 2022 (Friday).

- ♦ a copy of HKID card;
- a copy of academic transcript(s);
- a copy of full COVID-19 vaccination record;
- a copy of Report of Experiential Learning Activities (ELA Report) / any proof of extra-curricular activities;
- a copy of award(s) or scholarship(s);
- a recommendation form (returned directly by the referee); and
- ◆ 1 passport-sized photo with your name and student ID written at the back (Successful candidates will have to submit one more photo upon signing the undertaking)
