# Post-registration Diploma in Midwifery Program



## Programme Description

- ✿ The programme prepares students for registration as registered midwives with the MWCHK
- ✿ The programme integrates both the theoretical component and clinical practicum to equip students with the knowledge, attitude, and skills to provide quality, woman-centered midwifery care to the woman and her family

## Programme Structure

### Theoretical Component:

- ✿ The students are required to complete 3 units of 7 courses which are designed to enhance their learning progressively, covering the knowledge required in taking care of women with low-risk pregnancy as well as those with health problems
- ✿ The lecture will be conducted at the School of Midwifery in PWH

## Clinical Component:

- ✿ A minimum of 46 weeks of supervised clinical practice will be arranged to provide students with hands-on experience, mainly in the maternity units, but also extends to the community
- ✿ Clinical practicum will take place at the clinical training sites accredited by the MWCHK, which include:

  - Princess Margaret Hospital
  - Prince of Wales Hospital
  - Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital
