The introduction of a Professional Training Programme for students of the Interdisciplinary Major Programme in Global Economics and Finance with effect from 2013-14 was approved.

The proposal for exemptions from the University's Chinese Language Core Requirement for admission to the MBChB Programme with advanced standing with effect from 2013-14 was approved.

The recommendation to revise the exemption criteria of two Faculty Package courses for MBChB students admitted to the new six-year curriculum in and after 2013-14 with outstanding results in Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education examination was approved.

The Statutes of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (Amendment) Statutes 2013 that would give effect to the reorganization of the Council that was proposed and approved in 2009, was noted in accordance with Statutes 11.8.(1)(a) and 14.4.(1) of the University Ordinance for report to the Council.

A vote of thanks to Professor Lin Chen, Professor, Department of Finance and Choh-Ming Li Professor of Finance, Professor Liu Pak Wai, Professor of Economics, and Professor Yum Tak Shing, Peter, Professor of Information Engineering, was recorded for their significant contributions to the University, and in particular in their capacity as members of the Senate upon their retiring from the present post or leaving the University.

A vote of thanks to Mr. Terence C.W. Chan, University Bursar, who would retire from his post, was also recorded for his significant contributions to the University.
