The introduction of a study option offered by the Dickson Poon School of Law, King's College London for students of the Bachelor of Laws Programme with effect from 2019-20 was approved.

The recommendations of the Committee on Re-approval of Sub-degree Programmes for two self-financed sub-degree programmes, for the extension of the coverage of the re-approval policy to sub-degree, professional and continuing education programmes up to Level 6 of the Qualification Framework, and for renaming the Re-approval Committee to Committee on Re-approval of Sub-degree, Professional and Continuing Education Programmes were approved.
