Hong Kong Housing Society Award (Bursary) 2022/23

Background

Hong Kong Housing Society (HKHS) is a non-government and not-for-profit organization established in 1948, with an aim to serve the needs of the Hong Kong community in housing and related services. Since its inception, HKHS has been constantly identifying the housing needs of different sectors of the community and developing various housing options attuned to their needs. Besides, HKHS is committed to promoting professional development and knowledge sharing, for the benefit of long-term development of the housing sector. To this end, Hong Kong Housing Society Academy (HKHSA) was set up in 2005, with the objective of supporting academic excellence and professional development in housing-related disciplines, through a wide range of academic exchange activities, sponsorship and award schemes for the tertiary institutions in Hong Kong and Mainland China.

Value of the Awards

Successful applicants will be granted a bursary of HK\$10,000 in support of their studies.

Eligibility

Applicants should:

- (i) be permanent residents of Hong Kong
- (ii) be full-time undergraduate students majoring in Architectural Studies or Gerontology
- (iii) have completed at least the first year of study and attained Cumulative GPA 2.8 or above or equivalent; and
- (iv) be able to demonstrate his/her need for financial assistance. In general, the total household income including the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance from the government, and all remittances, alimony or contributions received, should not exceed the following amount*:

Application Procedures

Late or incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

- (i) A completed application form with signature and date
- (ii) A photocopy of transcript or the unofficial transcript downloaded from CUSIS
- (iii) A photocopy of HKID card
- (iv) An essay of 250-300 words in English (please refer to the application form for the essay question)
- (v) A link of video (less than 1 minute) in either English or Chinese to share your learning outcome apart from the written essay as mentioned in (iv)
- (vi) Copies of relevant documents supporting applicant's present financial situation, e.g. income proof for household members
- (vii) For casual workers, persons occupied in short-term employment, hawkers and self-employed persons, please fill out Appendix I, Self-prepared Income Form (收入自述書), and
- (viii) Reference letters, if any

- (i) The result would be announced in early 2023 via OAFA.
- (ii) Awardees will automatically become the members of the HKHS Academy Alumni Club (Alumni Club). All HKHS awardees are obliged to take part in at least three social service/ professional development activities organized by Alumni Club in 2022/23 and attend the Hong Kong Housing Society Award Presentation Ceremony, which is tentatively scheduled for January 2023.
