<u>Notes for Applicants on</u> <u>Request for ANSO Member Recommendation</u>

- I. Please follow the steps as stated below to submit your request for ANSO Member Recommendation:
 - Step 1: Submit your application for the ANSO Scholarship 2023, including finishing your online admission application to USTC/UCAS for admission in 2023, as stated in the ANSO website (http://www.anso.org.cn/programmes/talent/scholarship/).
 - Step 2: Ask your referee to submit the completed and signed "Recommendation Form (for ANSO members only)" to the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid (OAFA) <u>DIRECT</u>.
 - The designated recommendation form is available at <u>http://admission.cuhk.edu.hk/assets/oafa/Scholarships/Overseas/anso-2023-Member_Recommendation_Form.pdf</u>.
 - Your referee must be a current academic staff of CUHK <u>and</u> a person under whom you have studied at CUHK.
 - The referee should send the recommendation form to OAFA by email to <u>sfas@cuhk.edu.hk</u> with his/her CUHK email account <u>on or before 3 January 2023</u> (Hong Kong time).
 - You or your referee should **NOT** return the recommendation form to ANSO direct though ANSO's contact information is provided on the last page of the form.
 - The recommendation must be in either English or Chinese.
 - Step 3: Complete and submit an online request form at <u>http://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=13658369</u> on or before 3 January 2023 (Hong Kong time).

You are required to upload the following documents to the online request form:

- Academic transcript(s) for <u>ALL</u> of your post-secondary programme(s) pursued/being pursued. For current students, the transcript should show the academic results up to the latest term.
- Copies of official academic transcripts with Explanation Notes of Grading System for exchange programme(s), visiting student programme(s) and overseas summer course(s) (if applicable)
- Graduation Certificate of previous degree(s) (if applicable)
- Copy of your regular passport (i.e. passport cover and the page with personal particulars)
- CV with brief introduction of research experience
- Detailed research proposal
- Proof of Chinese or English language proficiency, if any (e.g. TOEFL, IELTS test reports, etc.)
- II. A University Selection Panel will shortlist suitable candidates for consideration by ANSO, if deemed necessary.
- III. There is no guarantee that students recommended by ANSO members will be sponsored by the ANSO Scholarship. Everyone should pass the review process organized by USTC/UCAS.
- IV. The Scholarships and Financial Aid Section of the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid and/or donor will request applicants to submit further supporting documents for information, if deemed necessary.
- V. The decisions of the University and/or the donor are final and not subject to review, and the reasons for shortlisting, nominating, granting or refusing to offer an award will not be given.
