Professor Anthony Green is a lecturer in Organic Chemistry and BBSRC David Phillips Research Fellow in the University of Manchester. He obtained his MSc in Chemistry from the University of Nottingham in 2005, and graduated with a PhD in Organic Chemistry from the University of Manchester in 2010. He worked as a PDRA in the University of Manchester and ETH Zurich during 2010-2015, and has returned to the University of Manchester in 2016 serving the current positions.

He has received numerous awards, including EPSRC Doctoral Prize (2009-2010), BBSRC David Phillips Research Fellowship (2016-2021) and ERC Starter Grant (2018-2023). His research interests center on Protein engineering, enzyme design, directed evolution, organic synthesis, industrial biocatalysis, biochemical/biophysical enzyme characterization, molecular biology and high-throughput screening, production/characterization of enzymes with non-canonical functionality.
