Professor Xingang Zhang is a Professor of Organic Chemistry of Key Laboratory of Organofluorine Chemistry, Shanghai Institute of Organic Chemistry, Chinese Academy of Sciences. He graduated with a PhD in organic chemistry from Shanghai Institute of Organic Chemistry, CAS in 2003. After postdoctoral studies in the area of chemical biology at University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (UIUC), he joined the faculty team of SIOC from 2008. He is an awardee of the RSC Fluorine Chemistry Prize (2015) and the 5th Chinese Chemical Society-Royal Society of Chemistry Young Chemist Award (2015).

His research interests lie primarily in the area of Organometallic fluorine chemistry and Late-stage fluoroalkylation of biologically active molecules and their applications in medicinal chemistry and Chemical biology in combination with organofluorine chemistry.
