## What do interviewers want to know?

- Are you prepared (for the interview and exchange)? Are you sincere? http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/sci/ssep/
- What are your strengths and weaknesses? (language skills, maturity, characters, ...)
- Why you want to join an exchange program?
- What image will you project as a CUHK representative?
- How will you/CUHK be benefited?
- Why you?

# Some common pitfalls

- Poor preparation do you know what you are getting into?
- Recitation of 'model answers'
- No clear idea of what one (you!) wants to get/do
- Self-centered: only knows what himself/herself wants
- Lack of sincerity and honesty don't try to hide behind model answers
- 'Bookworm' image
- Immature, too dependent, lack of confidence
- Lack of communication skills (not just language)

## Some more advices from an old man

- Take this as an opportunity to think through what you want to do/be
- Exercise: be your own interviewer!
- Critically examine your strengths/weaknesses
- Critically examine your motivation
- Critically examine your plan/direction
- Are you driven by yourself? Or are you just following others' footsteps/expectations?
