

Bernard Van Zuiden Music Prize

Candidate for this award should be Chung Chi final year student majoring in Music whose academic performance in previous years is considered to be of utmost excellence.

Kong Yue Kau Memorial Scholarship

Candidate for this award has to be undergraduate or postgraduate who should be outstanding in course(s) related to Cantonese Opera, and he/she is enthusiastic in pursuing research in Cantonese Opera.

Lee Bing Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship aims to finance an annual scholarship to be awarded to a Chung Chi graduate as encouragement and merit support to pursue postgraduate vocal studies at a well-recognized overseas university or conservatory. The recipient of the Scholarship should be a Chung Chi final year student or graduate of any discipline. He/She should have an outstanding academic record and should have obtained a good honour degree from University (1st Class or 2nd Honour). He/She should demonstrate potential in vocal studies and be admitted to a higher degree programme in vocal studies at a well-recognized overseas university or conservatory. Preference will be given to the one having financial need.

Lee King Fei Scholarship

For a local full-time undergraduate student from the Departments of Fine Arts, Music or Sports Science and Physical Education. For a Year 1 student, he/she must have outstanding academic achievements at entrance; or for a Year 2 or above student, he/she must have attained a Year GPA of 3.0 or above in the previous academic year. Financial need will also be considered. The Chairmen of the Departments of Fine Arts, Music and Sports Science and Physical Education will each be invited to nominate ONE suitable candidate to compete for the Scholarship.

Lo Kui Chuen Memorial Scholarship

The recipient of the Scholarship should be a Chung Chi undergraduate student majoring in Music, with piano as major instrument. The recipient should have a term GPA of not less than 3.00 in the previous term. The scholarship would be awarded primarily on the basis of academic merit, with also the consideration of candidates' financial needs.

Michael E. McClellan Music Essay Prize

For a full-time undergraduate student. The student must submit an essay on a subject related to music. The essay must have been written as a course assignment for a course offered by the Department of Music during the year and should be nominated by the course instructor.

Ng Tai Kong Memorial Scholarship

The recipient should be actively involved in Chinese music performance, Chinese music conducting, Chinese music composing, or other activities in Chinese music, and have a term GPA of not less than 3.00 in the previous term. In addition, he/she should submit a good essay (in Chinese or English) on the topic "Ng Tai Kong and Chinese Music" to the Department of Music for assessment.

Parsons Music Foundation Scholarships

The scholarship is to be awarded to a Chung Chi Music student, who will enroll in summer study programme outside Hong Kong. The recipient must be a Chung Chi undergraduate from the Department of Music whose overall GPA in the preceding term(s) must not be below 3.00. Scholarship recipient(s) should present for a sharing/performance session of his/her summer programme.

The Composers and Authors Society of Hong Kong Ltd. Scholarship

One undergraduate and one postgraduate student of the Department of Music, who have accomplished outstanding performance in composition courses.

The Hong Kong Children's Choir Music Scholarship

For local full-time undergraduate students of the Department of Music. Students must have attained an average GPA of at least 3.0. Priority will be given to students with voice major. Awardees are required to provide 20 hours of music related services such as providing support for music library and choral classes at The Hong Kong Children's Choir. The services with The Hong Kong Children's Choir are for the awardees to better understand the organization and the awardees will take part in the services on a voluntary basis.

To Yuet Lai Scholarships

For full-time undergraduate students. Based on academic merit in the previous year (GPA 3.0 or above). Candidate(s) should have represented CUHK and received INTERNATIONAL PRIZES in areas of academic-related activities, sports or other talents.

Tong Tik Sang Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship aims to enhance the knowledge and appreciation of Cantonese Opera among students of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, who have talent and strong interest in Cantonese Opera. The recipient(s) should be Chung Chi undergraduate of any discipline. In the case of a team work, the leader should be a Chung Chi student. The recipient(s) should submit a Cantonese Opera song or a short piece of Cantonese Opera Excerpt script.

Woo Sau Wing Scholarships

For a full-time undergraduate student of the Department of Music. Based on academic merit.

Yam & Pak Scholarship in Chinese Opera

Candidate(s) for this award should be music student(s) who has/have accomplished outstanding performance in Chinese opera courses; and/or have a plan to undertake research in Chinese Opera.
