Description

How to engage society through artistic and creative strategies? This course is designed to respond to this question with first-hand experience. This course provides internship placements for students to work with organizations involved in social engagement through creative thinking.

Designed in an inter-disciplinary approach, students will be able to work closely with artists, social workers, entrepreneurs, designers, therapists, architects, etc. Besides art administrative works, students are expected to create art projects and assist the organizations in running creative projects during the placement period. Through practical experience and reflection, students are expected to build capacity to conduct socially-engaged projects on their own in future.

Period of placement usually lasts from <u>June to August</u>. Students are expected to complete <u>at least 180 hours</u> with our partners. All interested students must attend the briefing session, as well as the two workshops in May and October. This course can be taken as either an Art History or a Studio Arts elective course but students are required to declare their choice of attribution in their final year of attendance.

PRESENTATION

Your presentation should be around 10-15 mins, including Q&A sessions, in either Cantonese or English. Consider this as a draft of your report. You could talk about your experience and contribution. But remember to share some of your reflections too. Suggested flow of presentation for your reference (criteria for grading):

- A) The internship partner's philosophy (How well do you understand them?);
- B) What did you do during the internship? (Are you passionate about it?);
- C) Your own reflection about the topics and strategies that our partners are working on;
- D) Observation about the general public you met during the internship (You have met different people during the internship for sure. What is your experience with them?);
- E) Your understanding about 'Art and Social Engagement' (Share your insight regarding to such notion. Needless to be theoretical. Try to form your own thoughts here)
- + photos / videos

Of course, each internship experience is so unique. These are not the only judging requirements. Yet, feel free to use this as a flow for your presentation. You may think of new points during the process.

REPORT (Need Veriguide**)

As mentioned, don't feel pressure about the report. You have completed basically 80% of the report if you prepare your presentation well. Just phrase your ideas and thoughts from the presentation into sentences for this report. It should be around 1500 words(either Chinese or English), including photos.
