- 2) Acrylic paint (2 or 3 contrasting colors)
- 3) Paper for making stencil
- 4) 1 sponge (handicraft sponge or dishwashing sponge is fine)
- 5) Scissors
- 6) 1 cork LED lights (Available in Apliu Street, Sham Shui Po)
