#### Hong Kong Young Ambassador Scheme 2011/12

The Hong Kong Young Ambassador Scheme 2011/12 is now open for enrolment. Young people selected for the Scheme will receive training this summer and become Young Ambassadors for Hong Kong to promote hospitality both locally and overseas.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend selection interviews to be conducted on 8, 9 or 10 July 2011. A comprehensive training programme for selected candidates will take place from 25 July to 31 August 2011. The training programme includes workshops, seminars, visits to Hong Kong leading companies as well as a "Young Service Stars" Competition. Upon satisfactory completion of the training, participants will be formally appointed as Hong Kong Young Ambassadors with the mission to promote "A Hospitable Hong Kong" in the coming academic year.
