He has served the community in his capacity as a Council Member of the University of Hong Kong, and the Council Member of Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority. Mr. Huang is now the Chairman of the Council of the City University of Hong Kong; the Chairman of the Standing Committee on Language Education & Research; and a Court Member of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. Mr. Huang is our alumnus of Master of Education in Education Policy and Leadership.
