- Research proposal (5 pages in English)
- Up to two academic writing sample(s) in English/Chinese/Japanese (if any)
- Japanese proficiency may apply
- Interview for shortlisted candidates

Tuition Waiver Scheme (By Government)

- Starting from the 2018-19 academic year
- For LOCAL FULL-TIME RPg students enrolled in UGC-funded RPg programmes
- For entire normative study period

Other Alternatives

- Self-funded M.Phil (full-time or part-time)
- Self-funded Ph.D program (full-time or part-time)
- HK\$42,100 per annum regardless of the study mode
