What can I do after graduating with a BScPH or BScCHP from CUHK?

What is the application procedure?

The exemption will be automatically assessed upon receiving the final Bachelor transcript from the students. The application is subject to the decision of the Graduate Division concerned and the Graduate School.

This Scheme is specially designed for our BScPH and BScCHP graduates aims to ease transition from their bachelor programme to advance to MPH programme. With the advantages of having course exemptions, this Scheme creates a bridge between the programme, providing an extended education in the field of Public Health.

What are the requirement?

You should apply the MPH programme within 3 years of obtaining the BScPH or BScCHP degree from CUHK.

What courses can be exempted?

A maximum 12 units can be exempted from the 36-unit MPH programme.
