Chinese New Year, also called the Spring Festival, is our most important festival. The festival starts on the first day of the first month of the Chinese lunar calendar, the day before the Spring Festival is called Chinese New Year's Eve, and all family members get together for a big meal on this day. At the same time, everyone celebrated with each other.

In addition, there is a custom of "Shou Sui". The all-night vigil symbolizes driving away all evil and warm diseases and looking forward to an auspicious new year. In the past, at 12 o'clock in the evening, adults and children would set off firecrackers, and the whole sky was brightly lit and very lively. However, in recent years, based on the requirements of environmental protection, people rarely set off firecrackers.

On the first early morning of one year, many people get up early and they stick the reversed Fu which represented that the happiness is coming. The New Year lasts fifteen days. During these 15 days, we always visit our relatives from house to house, at that time the children are happiest because they can get a lot of red pockets from their parents, grandparents, uncles, aunts.

The last day of the new year is another festival, which is called the Lantern Festival, which mainly includes a series of traditional folk activities such as viewing lanterns, eating sweet dumplings, and guessing lantern riddles. That is all about Spring festival.
