

Getting Connected to CSL Wi-Fi Service – Macintosh Users

(This document describes how to connect to CSL Wi-Fi Service using a Macintosh Mac OS X. Before using this service, you should first sign up for your [Wi-Fi Account](#).)

A. Detect a CSL Hotspot Connection

1. Turn on the Wi-Fi function of your computer

- Click at the top menu bar



OR

- Open System Preference -> Network

You should see the available wireless networks in the list.

Click **Refresh network list** if you cannot find CSL in the list.

Choose **CSL** and then click **Connect**.




B. Connect to the CSL Wi-Fi Service

1. Open your browser and visit any homepage e.g. <http://www.cuhk.edu.hk>.

Your browser will automatically lead you to the login page below.

2. Click Roaming & Other users.




3. At "Please choose your user category" page,

- Choose "The Chinese University of Hong Kong" from "University and Tertiary Institutes Users"



4. At the "login" page,

- Login ID:
your_Computing_ID*
*for student: s0123456
for staff: b012345
- Make sure "cuhk.edu.hk" is selected in the select box.
- Password: the password you have created for this programme
- Click "Login"




5. After successful login, you may enjoy CSL Wi-Fi service for at most 4 hours. After 4 hours, you will be prompted to login again. Repeat Step 1 - 4.

6. While using the Wi-Fi service, please also observe the [Best Practices For Accessing Public Wi-Fi Service](#) advised by Office of Telecommunications Authority.

Note: You should not close this page while using the CSL Wi-Fi Service. Otherwise, you will be asked to login to the CSL Wi-Fi Service again.

C. Disconnect from the CSL Wi-Fi Service

1. Click **Disconnect** when you want to terminate your CSL Wi-Fi connection.
