Abstract

This seminar focuses on engineering assessment from a global accreditation perspective. Very often, departments become overwhelmed with the work required to prove that a program complies with accreditation standards. This disposition is particularly true when addressing student outcomes or graduate attributes. This session addresses ways to engage in embedded assessment efficiently and productively. It will also demonstrate methods and strategies for benchmarking the achievement of student outcomes, the interpretation of collected data, and other useful approaches for determining accreditation conformity based on data. This event will be highly interactive where participant comments and questions are most welcome.

Biography

John Impagliazzo is Professor Emeritus at Hofstra University, New York, where he had served as its department chair and the director of its graduate programs. He has served as an ABET (formerly the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology) and a Computer Science Accreditation Commission (CSAC) accreditation team chair and program evaluator and has led or participated on visiting teams for almost fifty computing-related programs worldwide. John is also a member of the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) Education Board, a member of ACM's Education Council, and previously chaired the ACM Accreditation Committee for twelve years.
