

Check-In Notice for Exchange Residential Students of New Asia College, Semester 2 in 2022/2023

A. E-Card Reader for Entering and Leaving Hostels

The hostels have been installed the e-card reading system for recording resident's entry and exit records. Residents will need to use their CU Link Card to tap on the card reading devices for entering and leaving the hostels.

B. Check-in Procedures

1. Upon admission to the assigned hostels, residents are required to:
 - a. Present their CU Link cards (HKID card or Passport) for verification
 - b. Check their body temperature at hall counter
 - c. Provide one passport-sized photo and fill in the Resident Registration Form and Health Declaration Form (provided by staff of hall counter)
2. Students who have fully vaccinated 14 days before the check-in day **MUST** bring along their original vaccination records as proof for check-in.
3. After completion of the check-in procedure, please collect the room key from the hall counter.

C. Check-in Periods

Students should check-in to assigned hostels during check-in periods. If they do not report their late check-in within respective check-in periods at nahostel@cuhk.edu.hk, their hostel places will be forfeited.

D. Medical surveillance and/or Self-monitoring Arrangements

Inbound residents are required to undergo rapid antigen tests (RATs) daily until Day 3 of their arrival at Hong Kong and take a photo of the results daily and keep in on their mobile device for inspections when requested by the Government.
