#### **Find Your Project**

1-2 semesters before GEMC3001

- Find your own service work such as a selfdesigned project or unpaid formal internship with an NGO
- 2. Submit the project proposal to the GE team.
- Be sure to submit a project proposal online.
- Paid internships cannot be considered service work.
- You will need to coordinate with a supervisor and supply them with a Supervisor Evaluation Form. This form must be given to your supervisor before you submit a proposal to the GE team.

#### **General Education Team Approval**

 The GE team will email you once your project has been approved. You must wait for approval before you begin your service work.
