Yi's wife, a goddess.

The Supreme God of All the Heavens

The Ruler of all the gods.



Yao, Emperor of China

(Yao rhymes with "now")

Ruler of China 5,000 years ago (2356–2255 BC) when the country was centred round the Yellow River.



Feng Meng (pronounced Ferng Merng)

A champion archer; Yi's pupil.



The Goddess Xi He (pronounced Hsee Her)

Wife of the God of the Eastern Heavens; mother of the Sun Children.

The God of the Eastern Heavens

A god inferior to the Supreme God; father of the Sun Children.

Queen Mother of the West

Also known as Xi Wang Mu, maker of the Elixir of Life.
