

Lee Woo Sing College, The Chinese University of Hong Kong Hostel Application (Summer Residence, 2021)

Note to Applicants (All Students of All Cohorts)

Applicants should read the following note carefully before submitting their hostel applications.

General information

1. Hostel places (only single-occupancy rooms are available) in the College campus will be offered to students of Lee Woo Sing College for summer residency 2021. Students of all cohorts are eligible to apply.
2. The summer residence is divided into two sub-periods:

Period A	Period B
18 th May to 5 th July 2021	5 th July to 27 th August 2021 for local students; or 5 th July to 4 th September 2021 for non-local students

3. Due to CoVID-19 epidemic, summer residence 2021 will be offered for students with genuine needs of accommodation (supporting documents are required to be submitted upon application for approval) during summer periods.
4. All Lee Woo Sing College students are eligible to apply for hostel accommodation, except students being banned from hostel residency in 2020/21 residential year. Final-year/ graduating students can apply for Period A only.
5. All applicants applying for hostel residency shall agree to be abided by the Student Hostel Regulations upon their submission of application.

Fees

6. The hostel fees for summer residence 2021 are listed below. Those fees are to be paid in a single installment which will due by late-May 2021. Failure to pay the required fees will lead to immediate disqualification of summer residency. Each successful applicant is required to pay HKD500 as hostel deposit.

Application Procedures

7. Only online application is accepted. The application period is from 31st March to 16th Apr 2021 (12:00nn). Late or incomplete application will not be handled. Please complete the online application form here: <https://cloud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=12734492>

Application Results

8. Application results will be announced on the College website in a week time after application closed. Since only single-occupancy rooms are available, applicants do not have to submit online “Roommate Preference Form” to indicate their roommate preference.

Move-in and Move-out dates

9. Successful applicants must complete a check-in form and move-in the hostel at the time specified on the confirmation email to be sent to them upon release of application results.
10. Students should move-out before 11:00am on 5th July 2021 (Period A only) and 11:00am on 27th August 2021 (Period B inclusive) respectively. No extension of stay is allowed or request of such will be entertained.
11. When moving out, students should clean their rooms, defrost the fridge and clear out all belongings, and return all hostel properties to the College Office. Otherwise, fees will be deducted from the hostel deposit for cleaning and maintenance.

Special Notice for Students Travelling from Outside Hong Kong

12. Students travelling from outside Hong Kong or intend to travel outside Hong Kong and coming back to hostel should note that the College does not provide any Mandatory Home Quarantine (MHQ) accommodation, and will not issue letter of MHQ for flight/ vessel/ train boarding and immigration purposes. Students must arrange themselves any MHQ accommodation in town if it is required by the Government. Students who has left Hong Kong and returning to Hong Kong via the Return2HK Scheme must notify the College in advance when they have a plan to do so. Special accommodation for additional 14-days Medical Surveillance will be arranged. The College reserves the rights to deny admission to hostel if students failed to comply with the requirements.

Withdrawal

13. Successful applicants who would like to withdraw from summer residency before move-in shall write to the College Office before the move-in date; Students who would like to withdraw from summer residency after move-in shall write to the College Office one month in advance of the planned last date of stay. Otherwise, they have to pay in-lieu for the short notice period.

14. The hostel places vacated by students who withdrew from their hostel places will be assigned by the Hostel and College Facilities Management Committee to other applicants on the waiting list.

15. Lee Woo Sing College Hostel and College Facilities Management Committee reserves the final right of allotting the hostel places.
