# 政府「全日制大專學生免入息審查貸款計劃」2017/18 申請辦法 (新生)

「全日制大專學生免入息審查貸款計劃」是由政府在職家庭及學生資助事務處轄下的學生資助處(學 資處)提供的貸款計劃。申請人無須通過入息審查,最高貸款額為該學年應繳學費。詳情請參閱學資 處網頁http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk。

### 申請資格

- ◆ 本校註册的全日制本地學生;
- ◆ 所就讀的學額及所修的學位課程是全數由政府大學教育資助委員會或公帑所資助(有關認可課程,可 瀏覽學資處網頁http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk/sfo/tc/postsecondary/tsfs/general/coding.htm,查閱「資助專上 課程學生資助計劃」的課程編號一覽表);
- ◆ 擁有香港特別行政區(簡稱「香港」)居留權,或在課程開始前,申請人或其家庭已連續在香港居住 滿三年。這並不包括持有香港學生簽證的留學生;及
- ◆ 申請人只可於同一學年內,就一個合資格的全日制課程申請資助。

#### 網上遞交申請

◆申請人可透過政府「學資處電子通 - 我的申請」網上平台http://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk 遞交申請,新生網上遞交申請的截止日期為2017年9月22日。

### 遞交聲明書及證明文件

- ◆ 同學遞交申請後,必須將聲明書、申請所需的證明文件及已繳付行政費用(HK\$260)的銀行收據或自動櫃員機的轉帳通知書副本上載、郵寄或親身遞交予學資處,同學亦可於 2017 年 9 月 21、22 及 25 至 29 日上午 8 時 45 分至下午 1 時及下午 2 時至 5 時 30 分,把有關文件投入設於本校康本國際學術園 12 樓 1206 室入學及學生資助處經濟援助組的收集箱。
- ◆ 同學必須把聲明書及申請所需的證明文件,預先用釘書機釘好,才投入收集箱內。

### 注意事項

- ◆同學必須於遞交申請前,仔細閱讀「申請指引」,該指引已上載於學資處網頁 http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk/sfo/tc/postsecondary/nlsft/application/forms.htm。
- ◆ 同學填寫申請書時,請參考政府「學資處電子通 我的申請」網頁https://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk/demo/tc/的網上示範。
- ◆學資處會向成功申請人發出「發放貸款通知書」,列明免入息審查貸款的發放金額及日期。若免入息 審查貸款於學費到期日前發放予中大,該貸款便會直接用作支付學費。
- ◆ 若申請人未能在學費到期日前收到「發放貸款通知書」或免入息審查貸款的發放日期遲於學費到期日,同學便須於學費單上的到期日前先自行繳交學費。如果免入息審查貸款在到期日後才發放給中大,貸款便會存入免入息審查貸款計劃申請表上指定的銀行戶口。
- ◆學資處會在發放「資助專上課程學生資助計劃」的申請結果通知書內,同時通知申請人按「全日制 大專學生免入息審查貸款計劃」可獲得的貸款額。假如申請人希望接受有關貸款,可於學資處網頁 下載貸款文件,並於「資助專上課程學生資助計劃」通知書上所示日期或之前,親身或授權他人將 有關文件及已繳付行政費的銀行收據交回學資處。
- ◆ 若同學就讀深造(研究式)課程,而該課程於 2017 年 3 月至 2018 年 2 月期間開始,便應申請 2017/18 學年的貸款。截止日期為課程開始後一個月。在任何情況下均不可遲於 2018 年 3 月 31 日遞交申請。

# Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Full-time Tertiary Students (NLSFT) 2017/18 Submission Guidelines (New Students)

The Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Full-time Tertiary Students (NLSFT) is administered by the Government Student Finance Office of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFO). It provides non-means-tested loans to students up to the amount of payable tuition fees. For details, please visit the website of SFO at <a href="http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk">http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk</a>.

### **Eligibility**

- ♦ Applicants should be registered as a full-time student in The Chinese University of Hong Kong;
- ♦ Applicants must take up exclusively UGC-funded or publicly-funded student places of recognized programmes as listed in the Course Coding Sheet. (The Course Coding Sheet is available at SFO's website: <a href="http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk/sfo/en/postsecondary/tsfs/general/coding.htm">http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk/sfo/en/postsecondary/tsfs/general/coding.htm</a>);
- ♦ Applicants should have the right of abode in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (Hong Kong) or have resided or have had their home in Hong Kong continuously for 3 complete years immediately prior to the commencement of the course. This does not cover students who are staying in Hong Kong with student visas; and
- ♦ Students can only submit an application for one eligible full-time course in any particular academic year.

### **Online Submission of Application**

♦ Applicants may submit their applications through "SFO E-link – My Applications" online platform at <a href="http://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk">http://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk</a>. New students should submit their online applications on or before 22 September 2017.

### **Submission of Declaration and Supporting Documents**

- After submission of the online form, applicants will be required to submit the declaration, supporting documents and a photocopy of the transaction advice or account deposit form for the administrative fee paid (HK\$260) by online uploading, by post or in person to SFO's office. Applicants may also submit the documents to the collection box at Room 1206, 12/F, Yasumoto International Academic Park from 8:45 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on 21, 22 and 25 to 29 September 2017.
- ♦ Applicants should staple the declaration and supporting documents together before submission.

#### Notes

- ♦ Applicants should study the "Guidance Notes" before submitting their applications. The Notes are available at <a href="http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk/sfo/en/postsecondary/nlsft/application/forms.htm">http://www.wfsfaa.gov.hk/sfo/en/postsecondary/nlsft/application/forms.htm</a>.
- ♦ Applicants may refer to the online demonstration at the homepage of SFO E-link My Applications (https://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk/demo/en/) when completing the application form.
- ♦ SFO will issue a Remittance Advice to successful applicants stipulating the amount of the NLSFT loan to be disbursed and the loan disbursement date. If the NLSFT loan is disbursed to CUHK before the tuition fee payment due date, the loan will be used to settle applicants' tuition fee payment directly.
- ♦ If applicants have not received the Remittance Advice before the tuition fee payment due date or the NLSFT disbursement date is later than the tuition fee payment due date, applicants are required to settle their tuition fee on or before the due date by themselves. If the NLSFT loan is disbursed to CUHK after the tuition fee payment due date, the loan will be paid to the bank account specified in NLSFT application form.
- ♦ TSFS applicants will be informed of the financial assistance they are entitled under TSFS and NLSFT, if any, simultaneously through the TSFS result notification. If they wish to accept the NLSFT loan offered, they may download the required loan documents from SFO website and submit the loan documents and the bank pay-in slip for the administrative fee paid in person or authorize a person to do so on their behalf to SFO on or before the deadline stated in their TSFS result notification.
- ♦ If applicants attend postgraduate courses (by research) that commence between March 2017 and February 2018, they should apply for NLSFT under the 2017/18 academic year. The application deadline is one month following the commencement of the course and in any case not later than 31 March 2018.
