Application Guidelines for Off-Campus Residence Grant 2022-2023

This Grant Scheme provides financial support to needy students who have not been assigned a residential place on the University campus, to rent a place off-campus temporarily, along the Mass Transit Railway System (East Rail Line). The rented place should be closer to the University compared with the family residence, to facilitate the applicant to participate in College life, for advancement in academic performance and for better participation in various activities on campus.

Eligibility

United College students on the waiting list of hostel residence application of 2022-2023 are welcomed to apply. (i.e. those who have not been assigned a residential place on the University Campus.).

**This application will not affect the chance of waiting or appealing for a hostel place.*

Grant Amount

The amount of each grant for 2022-2023 will be HK\$2,720. For each applicant, a maximum of two grants may be allocated for the 1st Term and 2nd Term of the academic year. (i.e. HK\$2,720 x 2 = HK\$5,440)

Application Method

The Grant is available for students throughout the year, please check with college staff for more details and obtain the application form. Return the completed form to the Dean of Students' Office.

**Applicants are required to submit documents on rental agreement and related proof. Verification of information will be made with the applicant and the parents, prior to grant allocation approval by the College.*
