**O'Camp Participants**

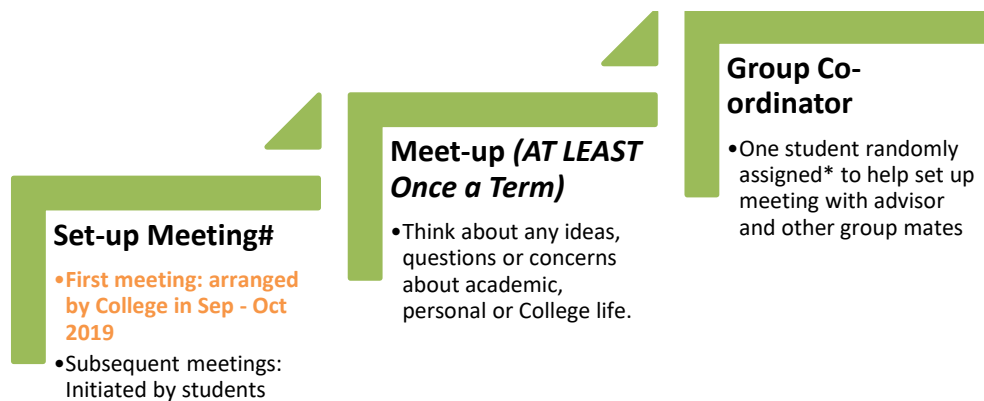
New students from the same small group of O'Camp will be in one group

*\*The faculty / profession of the advisor(s) will be matched with these 3 faculties as far as possible.*

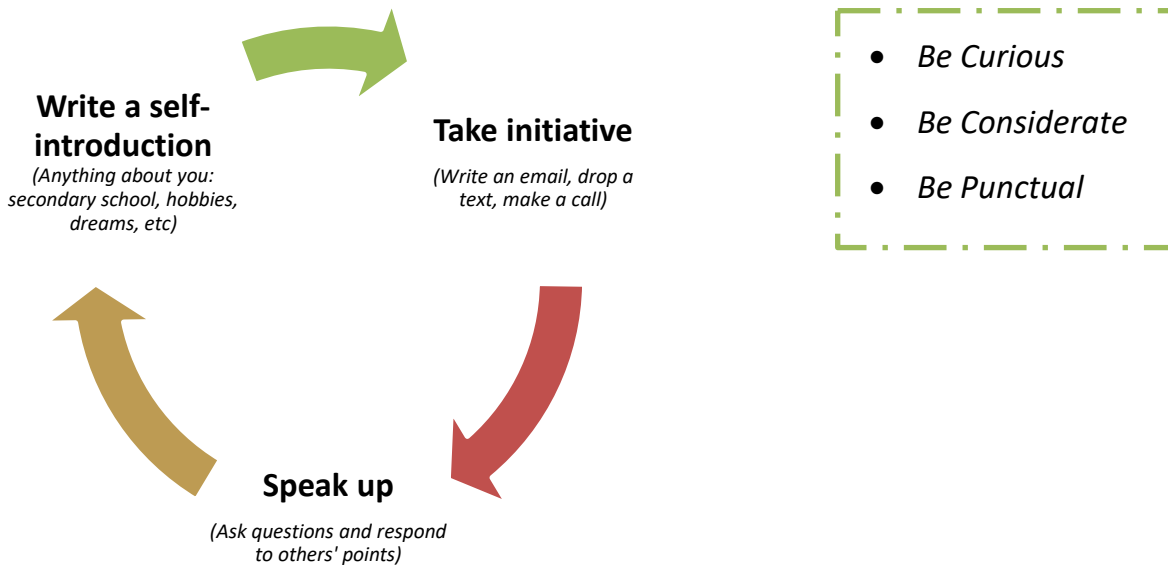
**HOW DOES IT WORK?**
