Training will be provided. Mr. Kennedy Ng, a very experience social worker with many years of work in youth development, will teach you the skills that you will need to become a great mentor.

Mentoring targets:

- youth with developmental needs or situated in at-risk or marginalized environment
- Form 1 or 2 students with special education needs (Taipo district)

Aim:

- guide those students and help them to become more socially engaged
- help them break away from the vicious cycle

1. Student Residency Bursary Scheme 2015/16 2015/16 年度中大學生宿舍助學金計劃

To be eligible to apply for the CUHK Student Residence Bursary, applicants must:

- (1) be local full-time undergraduate students;
- (2) be registered residents of the hostel and have resided in hostel for at least 75% of the time of the semester;
- (3) have an average monthly household income of roughly less than \$20,000 (during 1st Apr 2014 to 31st Mar 2015);
- (4) not be able to benefit from Community Care Fund (CCF) hostel subsidy or receive less than \$1,000 per semester under the CCF hostel subsidy.

The value of bursary will be maximum \$1,000 per semester. Eligible students who live in hostel for the first term or the whole year

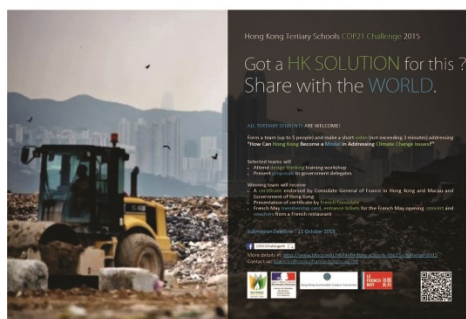
