### 1. Happy 8th Anniversary to Wu Yee Sun College! 8週年院慶慶祝活動 - Sunny Airline

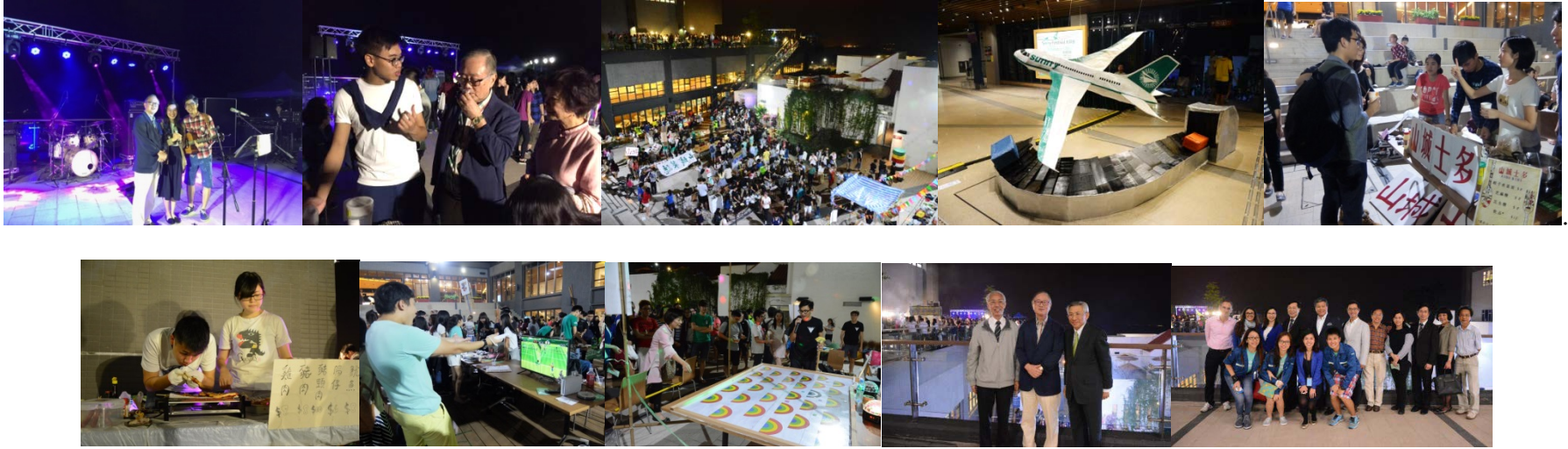


Happy Birthday to the Sunny College! Last week we enjoyed a series of celebration activities organized by the Organizing Committee and Sports Association.

There were over 45 booths, selling home-made snacks, hand-made accessories, playing games and etc. The night was accompanied by fabulous music shows starring our College students. More than 30 College Members, including Overseers Dr. Joseph Y.W. PANG (彭玉榮博士), Mr. Benedict N.Y. SIN (冼雅恩先生) and Mr. and Mrs. Albert P.C. WU (伍步昌伉儷), attended the Festival to show their support. Large-scale redevelopment projects were carried out in Sham Shui Po, abolishing old buildings and building luxury flats. Students learnt more about the issue of redevelopment in Hong Kong.

#### Regulations for the Use of Lockers

1. Users should take care of their personal belongings kept in lockers. The College will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
2. Users are responsible for cleaning the lockers and removing all the personal belongings inside them before returning the lockers to the College. After the stipulated period of use, any leftover items inside the lockers will be disposed of without further notification (no compensation will be made for destroyed locks).

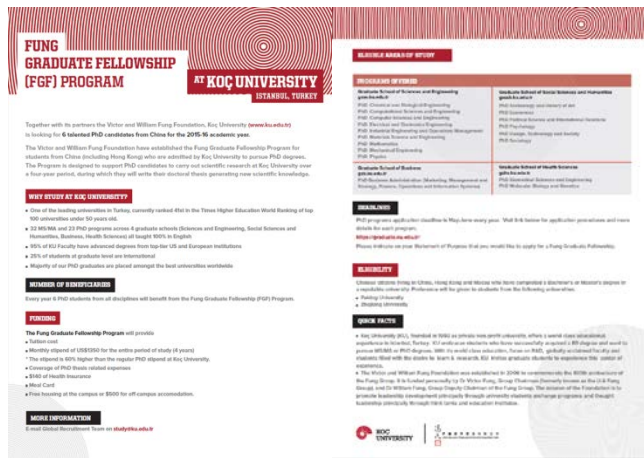

### 5. Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme 2016

The Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme (the Scheme) aims to provide recognition to outstanding undergraduates in universities in Hong Kong as well as opportunities to widen their international/Mainland exposure and gain industry experience. Twenty-five science undergraduates, to be nominated by the six local universities and selected by an Awardee Selection Committee of the Scheme, will each be awarded a **scholarship of up to HK\$150,000**. The Scheme comprises the following components:

- Financial support for Overseas/Mainland Attachment Programme(s) between 1 June 2016 and 30 June 2017 (at least one of the attachment programmes must be longer than three weeks)
- Mentorship Programme
- Service Project Programme
- Local Internship Programme (optional)

### Eligibility and Selection Criteria

The Scheme is open to full-time, **non-final-year undergraduates** who meet the following criteria:

- Hong Kong Permanent Residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong.
- Students majoring in the University Grants Committee-funded programmes offered by the Faculty of Engineering, Medicine or Science.
- Preferably cumulative GPA of 3.3 (or equivalent) or above.
- A minimum total TOEFL score of 90 (Internet-based test) with scores for individual sections not lower than 21 on reading, 22 on listening,

21 on speaking, and 17 on writing; or a minimum IELTS (Academic Test) overall band score of 6.5, with no component below 6.0. All tests must have been taken on or after 20<sup>th</sup> February 2014.

- Have passion in innovation and technology, and intention of pursuing this as a career.
- Well-rounded, have participated in extra-curricular and/or community service activities.
- Able to demonstrate commitment to Hong Kong.
- Possesses good communication skills.
- Have not received an award under this Scheme.

#### Application Procedures

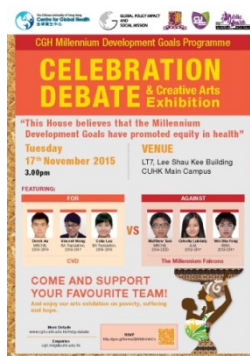
