The College Forum entitled "Green Tech, Green Finance and Sustainable Development Goals - Climate Change Solutions?" was conducted by Dr. William Yu (余遠騁博士), Founder and Chief Executive Officer, World Green Organisation, last Friday. Dr. Yu introduced how global businesses could contribute to sustainability. He shared some examples of corporates which dedicated in specific sustainable development goals (SDGs) and the development of green finance in the Asia and the Pacific Region.





Successful applicants will receive subsidy on reimbursement basis. For each successful application, each participant may receive, at most, HK\$100 subsidy for the activity.



Instead, she attended mainstream schools in Hong Kong, emigrated to Canada, obtained a double bachelor's degree in Economics and Psychology, a master degree in Counselling Psychology, and Diploma in Education. Later, she returned to Hong Kong and delve into the field of Psychology & Counselling Service and worked as a Case Management Consultant for the Senior Citizen Home Safety Association. To promote the social integration of the disabled, Jennifer went further and co-founded a social enterprise 'Codekey Cookies' with her visually impaired friends to sell Braille cookies.
